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¹ CDC list of moderately to severely immunocompromised conditions:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response

² Any COVID-19 vaccine other than Novavax can be used for the booster dose if the individual is eligible by age, though mRNA vaccines are preferred

³ A booster using Novavax COVID-19 vaccine is not currently authorized. Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) should be used only for those with contraindications to all other approved COVID vaccines or who refuse other approved COVID vaccines

⁴ A booster using Novavax COVID-19 vaccine is not currently authorized

⁵ Those who received Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) for first dose may receive additional full dose of Pfizer or Moderna, not an additional dose of Janssen (Johnson & Johnson)
