Asymptomatic Pre-procedure COVID Testing

Outpatient Pre-Procedure Testing:

- SVMC will no longer require asymptomatic patients undergoing an outpatient procedure to obtain a COVID-19 test prior to coming to SVMC for their procedure.
 - Policy applies to all patients, regardless of vaccination status, and all outpatient procedure types, MAC endoscopy procedures, interventional procedures etc.
 - o Patients will continue to undergo screening for COVID-related symptoms during their preregistration call, and upon entry into the hospital.
- Asymptomatic patients who come to the hospital in labor or for a planned induction will have a Rapid PCR test, source anterior nares, upon admission to WCS.
- Pre-procedure testing guidelines for symptomatic patients will remain unchanged.

In-Patient Pre-Procedure Testing:

- All patients undergoing in-patient procedures and outpatient to admits or emergency surgery will
 have a Rapid PCR test upon admission to the hospital. This is consistent with testing guidelines for
 all in-patients.
- Planned induction and C-Sections will have routine PCR on admission.
- Repeat testing not recommended for patients with positive Covid test within the past 90 days.

Provider and Patient Precautions:

- Staff and providers should don N95 mask or equivalent for aerosolizing procedures including all intubations and extubations.
- Staff and providers should don routine PPE for all other procedures.
- Patients must remain masked at all time in the hallways, during transfers and as appropriate in their room.
- Vaccine and boosters against COVID-19 is the best protection for staff, provider and patient safety.
